Please provide a statement of your interest in the Sonoma County Continuum of Care Board:

I have lived and worked in Sonoma County for more than ten years, with over a decade of experience in homelessness services and affordable housing development. As the Chief Executive Officer for Committee on the Shelterless (COTS,) I am well suited to represent the unsheltered community, as well as other homeless services providers in the greater Sonoma County area.

I am well acquainted with other service providers, programs offered, and the needs of the unsheltered community throughout Sonoma County. I am also well-versed in City, County, State, and Federal funding opportunities to support this work, and the importance of collaboration among providers and public entities within the region. I regularly attend City and County meetings and maintain strong working relationships with City and County officials, other service providers, and community members interested in this work.

I see great value in collaboration among CoC members and partners and would strive for additional collaborative opportunities to best serve the unsheltered population of Sonoma County. I also understand the importance of ensuring those with lived experience have a seat at the table—decisions should not be made without input and feedback from those who are impacted.



I would like to participate as a member of the Sonoma County CoC Board because I am an active resident of Sonoma County and have spent the last decade demonstrating my interest in best serving this population. I understand that policy changes impact our providers and will continue to dedicate my professional career to serving the unsheltered community throughout the region. I would be honored to work alongside agency staff, community members, and other providers to develop best practices for long and short-term impacts throughout Sonoma County.

My professional background includes working as a Chief Administrative Officer, Chief Operating Officer, and Chief Executive Officer within the homelessness services industry in Sonoma County. I also hold a board seat on the Community Benefit board for Providence Hospitals (Petaluma Valley and Healdsburg Hospitals,) a board seat for Legal Aid of Marin (legal aid for immigration and housing/tenant services) and I am the board President for Trips for Kids Bay Area (cycling and environmental education nonprofit for area youth.) I hold a B.S. in Business, and a Juris Doctorate.
