Hi, I'm most interested in working with the homeless. I live in south park, where we have many, many homeless...some with mental trouble, lot's with drug problems, drinkers and then the people who have not jobs and no way to support themselves. I've lived in Santa Rosa for almost 50 years, and in that time I hear people talking about the homeless in the summer, when it's fine to sleep outside, but once the weather changes I hear nothing. So please find places for them to stay.

Things that make me crazy...The old Senior Center and the old Art Start Center. I know it's got a kitchen and bathrooms...The Economy Inn on Santa Rosa Ave, also with bathrooms and beds, the stables on the Southside of the fairgrounds. People say "who'd want to sleep where horses have lived?" I would if my choice was sleeping in the rain or under a roof. Even if you gave each person 2 stalls it would house about 200 or more people. Yes, the city would have to have a couple of people who were guards to make sure people smoked outside.

I also think that people could pay for these spaces by picking up trash. We live in a world of trash, and I think Santa Rosa could afford a pair of gloves, and a five gallon can, and a picker-upper for each person. I'd get my son Aaron who is into trashing (the creeks and the rivers) and has a YouTube show called Taking Out Trash With Aaron, to teach them why trashing is so important to the world. Everyone would make so much per can to pay for their stay. They'd end up feeling better about themselves if they were paying their way. Also it would great to work with the Food Bank to get them food to eat.

We also need to create homeless parks, where the people on RV's could stay, with bathrooms and garbage cans.

I'm very big on garbage cans...where did they all go? I know lot's of people think that it's only the homeless who litter. But they are not. The Recology people litter, as they pick our trash, look at the amount of garbage that comes while they are emptying the cans. Who picks that up? Just everyday people litter as they walk along the streets. Next time you're walking see how many Covid masks are on the ground.

And for the homeless what has happened to the Port a Potties? Where are they suppose to poop and pee?

We need to find places for the homeless to live...and keep them in separate groups...so the drunks and the druggies aren't heaped together with the other homeless. I'm sure they'd appreciate it as much as I would.
